DARTMOUTH & AGATHA CHRISTIE'S "GREENWAY HOUSE"

This is an extraordinary glimpse into the private holiday home of the famous and much-loved author Agatha Christie and her family. The relaxed and atmospheric house is set in the 1950s, and contains many of the family's collections, including archaeology, Tunbridge ware, silver, botanical china and books. Outside you can explore the large and romantic woodland garden, with a restored vinery, wild edges and rare plantings, which drifts down the hillside towards the sparkling Dart estuary. To relieve pressure on congested lanes in the local village of Galmpton there is a traffic management system in place which means that groups are only able to visit by ferry.
