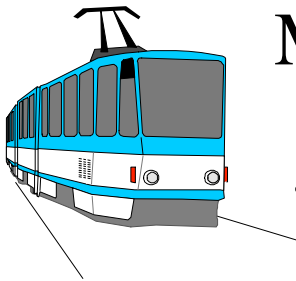


TAKE A RIDE ON THE SEATON TRAMWAY

2010 is Seaton Tramway's 40th Birthday! The Tramway provides a fabulous journey through East Devon's glorious Axe Valley, with the track following the course of the River Axe Estuary through two nature reserves. The Tramway provides excellent views of the many species of wading birds and wildlife, and links the coastal resort of Seaton with the ancient town of Colyton three miles inland. (The journey takes 25 minutes each way)

We depart Bretonside at 9am and take you directly to Seaton. You will have time for coffee before boarding the midday tram for the delightful 3-mile journey along the estuary of the River Axe to Colyton. Colyton Station houses the well-stocked shop, which has a range of tram-related souvenirs and unique gifts to suit all budgets. Next door is the Tram Stop Restaurant, offering an extensive menu of hot meals and snacks. The town centre is a short ten-minute walk from the station. After lunch you will return to Seaton on the 2.30pm tram. You will then have free time in Seaton before the coach departs at 4pm. We aim to be back into Bretonside approx. 6pm.
