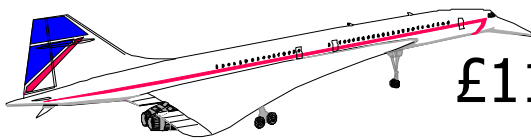


FARNBOROUGH AIRSHOW & THE FLEET AIR ARM MUSEUM

SATURDAY

We depart Bretonside at 8am and head towards Yeovilton's Fleet Air Arm Museum. It has the largest collection of naval aircraft anywhere in Europe together with the first British built Concorde which you can go on-board and visit the cockpit. The award winning Aircraft Carrier Experience is where you'll be "transported" by helicopter to the replica flight deck of the aircraft carrier HMS ARK ROYAL. On board the Ark Royal you'll see fighter aircraft and two enormous projection screens showing a Phantom strike fighter and a Buccaneer fighter-bomber. We will depart the Museum around 2pm and make our way to our Hotel to check in approx. 5pm, where you will enjoy an evening meal.

SUNDAY

After breakfast we depart our hotel and head to Farnborough for the highlight of the weekend. The Farnborough Air Show is a 7 day international trade fair for the aerospace business when many new orders and development announcements are made. It is open to the public for the last two days where you can wander around the indoor exhibition halls, view the static aircraft displays and of course the flying displays. Overall it is one of the biggest and best air shows held in this country and is not to be missed! We aim to arrive back in Plymouth around 9.30pm.
