FRIDAY - We depart Bretonside at 8am, making a comfort stop along the way, we aim to arrive at Monkey World around 11am. Set amongst the woodlands of Dorset lays 65 acres of sanctuary for over 240 primates. Monkey World is home to the largest set of chimpanzees outside of Africa, being home to endangered orangutans, gibbons, woolly monkeys, lemurs and stump-tailed macaques. By visiting you will be supporting a great cause as the majority of the residents have been rescued. We will depart Monkey World at 4pm and make our way to our hotel, arriving in good time for our evening meal.

SATURDAY – After breakfast we travel to Longleat where you will be issued with a passport ticket, allowing you entry to the Safari park, 1.48 acre hedge maze made up of 16,000 yew trees, a trip on the railway to view the sea lions, the beautiful Elizabethan stately home and gardens and for younger visitors the adventure castle, pets corner and postman pat village. We will depart Longleat at 4pm aiming to arrive back into Bretonside around 7pm.
