MONDAY - We depart Bretonside at 8am and make our way to Sanders Garden World for a coffee stop. We then proceed onto Stratford upon Avon where you will have time for lunch. We continue our journey to our hotel arriving late afternoon.

TUESDAY – Today our visit takes us to Ironbridge, birthplace of the Industrial Revolution where we will visit the Coalport China Museum; this is just one of ten museums that make up Ironbridge. In the afternoon we will visit the market town of Shrewsbury.

WEDNESDAY – This morning we take a 30 minute train ride from Carrog to Llangollen, and then embark on a narrow boat cruise through the Welsh borderlands along the Llangollen canal. We then travel to the Ewe-Phoria Sheepdog Training Centre. Meet the sheepdog puppies (when there is a litter), see a working sheepdog demonstration and a ram parade where you meet the different breeds of sheep and learn about shearing. This will be followed by tea / coffee and fresh scones at the bistro.

THURSDAY – We will have a tour through the Snowdonia National Park, visiting Betws – Y – Coed, travelling on through Festiniog to Port Meirion, the fantasy village location of "The Prisoner" TV series. Entry is included but if you wish to partake in any of the tours once there it will incur an additional cost.

FRIDAY – After breakfast we begin our journey home. We will make a stop at Ludlow – the culinary capital of England. We continue our journey making a further stop at the cathedral City of Hereford. We aim to arrive back in Bretonside around 6pm.
