SATURDAY - We depart Bretonside at 8am and stop for coffee before taking a lunch break at Haskins Garden Centre Ferndown. We then head to Winchester where we will meet our blue badge guide for our afternoon tour which lasts around 90 minutes and highlights the culture and architectural heritage of the city. We will then make our way to our hotel giving you time to relax and unwind before your evening meal is served.

SUNDAY – After breakfast we travel the short distance back into Winchester where you will have a 1 hour guided tour of the spectacular Cathedral. Its history dates back over 15 centuries and in its current state was constructed in the aftermath of the Battle of Hastings. Displayed in the Cathedral Library is the Winchester Bible, the largest and finest of all surviving 12th century English bibles. After lunch we will visit Winchester City Mill which was rebuilt in 1743 and after extensive restoration resumed grinding flour in 2004. You will discover a millennium of milling history, enjoy the milling demonstration and maybe even have a go at milling flour using hand querns. We depart Winchester making a comfort stop on the way home and aim to arrive into Plymouth around 8pm.
