**PLEASE NOTE: The Burlington Hotel does not have a lift, however public areas are easily accessible and there are 20 ground floor rooms which need to be requested at time of booking if required.**

**THURSDAY** - We depart Bretonside at 8am and make our way to Lymington to catch our ferry to the Isle of Wight. Comfort stops will be made along the way, with a longer break for lunch.

**FRIDAY** - We take a trip around the island today, taking in Alum Bay and The Needles the western most bay of the island, at the most westerly tip is the Needles with its 3 chalk Monoliths, stretching out to the Solent. We then travel to Arreton Barns Craft Centre

**SATURDAY** - This morning's visit takes us to the pretty village of Godshill, with its thatched roof cottages, tea gardens and gift shops. This afternoon we visit Ryde before making a visit to Waltzing Waters (entry included) where coloured jets of water dance to music.

**SUNDAY** - A free day today to relax and enjoy the hotels central location and spend the day in Sandown. Alternatively your driver will take to you Osborne House, for anyone wishing to visit Queen Victoria's country retreat (price not included - allow approx. £11 pp).

**MONDAY** - After breakfast we travel back to Yarmouth for our ferry crossing. We will visit Weymouth for lunch before continuing our journey back to Plymouth early evening.
