**MONDAY** – We depart Bretonside at 9am and make our way to Cheltenham where you will have time to explore the town and have lunch. We cross the River Severn and travel to our hotel with plenty of time to relax before our evening meal.

**TUESDAY** – Today we visit the town of Abergavenny, a picturesque town, steeped in history, bathing in the beauty of the Brecon Beacons National Park. This afternoon we travel through one of the valleys to St. Fagans Welsh Life Museum, one of Europe's leading open-air museums and Wales most popular heritage attraction. It stands in the grounds of the magnificent St. Fagans Castle, a late 16<sup>th</sup> century manor house donated to the people of Wales by the Earl of Plymouth.

**WEDNESDAY** – We spend the day in the capital city of Cardiff today. Cardiff has many landmark buildings such as the Millennium Stadium, Pierhead Building, the Welsh National Museum, the Senedd; the home of the National Assembly for Wales, Cardiff Castle, St. David's Hall, Llandaff Cathedral and the Wales Millennium Centre. A major £675 million regeneration of Cardiff's St. David's Centre was completed in 2009, providing 1,400,000 square feet of shopping, making it one of the largest shopping centres in the UK.

**THURSDAY** – Today we make our way to Hay on Wye, a little market town on the River Wye, within the Brecon Beacons National Park. Reputed to be the jewel in the crown of Wales and known as the "Town of Books" world famous for its second hand bookshops and book festivals. We then travel onto Hereford, with its Cathedral dating from 1079 and containing the Mappa Mundi, a medieval map of the world dating from the 13<sup>th</sup> century. It also contains the world famous Chained Library.

**FRIDAY** – Sadly we must head home today making a visit to Weston Super Mare. We leave at 3pm, aiming to arrive back into Bretonside approx. 6pm.
