**FRIDAY** - We depart Bretonside at 8am making a coffee stop on our way to Windsor where we will stop for lunch. You may wish to take a closer look at the castle or browse the shops or stroll along the river. We aim to arrive at our hotel around 5pm.

**SATURDAY** - Today we visit RHS Wisley Gardens, the flagship garden of the Royal Horticultural Society. It captures the imagination with richly planted borders, luscious rose gardens and state of the art glasshouse, all set amongst 240 acres of beautiful landscape.

**SUNDAY** - After breakfast we head in towards London to visit Kew Gardens & Kew Palace. Visit the Palm House and the Rose Garden; the Palm House was constructed in 1844 and took 4 years to complete and has become the gardens icon. Climb the 18 metre staircase to a walkway constructed high up among the tree tops. Kew Palace re-opened to the public in 2006 after a huge restoration, it is said to be the smallest of the English Royal Palaces and a favourite retreat for the Royals in the late 18<sup>th</sup> century. We will depart Kew and head back towards Plymouth aiming to arrive at 8pm.
