**MONDAY** – We depart Bretonside at 7.30am making a comfort stop and a longer break for lunch along the way. We aim to arrive at our hotel in Kent late afternoon in time for our first evening meal.

**TUESDAY** – Today we have an early unique guided tour of Leeds Castle 1 hour before it opens its doors to the public. You will see the cellars, banqueting hall and chapel, and have exclusive access to the castle's private state bedrooms which are not normally open to the public. This historic castle has been home to six medieval queens of England and a favourite royal palace of Henry VIII.

**WEDNESDAY** – This morning we will have a guided tour of Biddenden Vineyard where you will have the opportunity to sample some of the fabulous wine grown on site. This will be followed by a locally sourced Ploughman's lunch and a glass of wine and a chance to have a look in the Vineyard shop for souvenirs. This afternoon we will visit Royal Tunbridge Wells.

**THURSDAY** – Canterbury is our destination today. The Cathedral, St. Augustine's Abbey and St. Martin's Church form the world heritage site. There are also river tours, interesting museums and walking tours available. Also famous for Geoffrey Chaucer's Canterbury Tales, written towards the end of the 14<sup>th</sup> century.

**FRIDAY** – After breakfast we start our journey homewards. We will make refreshment stops and a lunch break along the way. We aim to arrive back into Plymouth around 8pm.
