

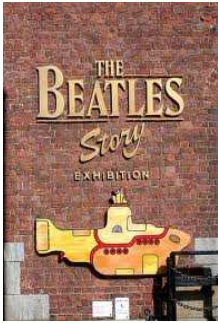

MONDAY - We depart Bretonside at 7am, stopping off for coffee at Blooms Garden Centre. We then continue our journey to Chester for a late lunch and to admire this beautiful city with its famous Tudor shopping isle's known as the "Rows". We then travel onto our hotel in the heart of Liverpool via the Mersey tunnel where you will have time to freshen up before your evening meal.

TUESDAY – This morning's visit is to the Port Sunshine Museum & Garden Village situated on the Wirral across the river. Built in 1888, the beautifully maintained village is set amidst 130 acres of parkland. It was built by William Hesketh Lever (later Viscount Leverhulme) to house his soap factory workers at Lever Brothers which eventually turned in to the global giant Unilever. You will enjoy tea and coffee refreshments before returning to Liverpool for a free afternoon.

WEDNESDAY – At 11am today we will embark on a one hour Yellow Duck Submarine ride where guests can view the city's attractions. You then travel down the slipway and into the Salthouse Dock before the duck emerges from the water, right in front of the Albert Dock buildings. You will then have some free time for lunch before meeting up with the group once again for a visit to the Beatles Story Museum. Follow the "fab-fours" career up close and personal from their early years to their break up and solo careers with a host of photographs and artefacts on offer.

THURSDAY – After breakfast we must start our journey home. We will stop off at Cheltenham, a delightful town full of beautiful gardens and regency buildings. You will have time for lunch and a stroll around before we continue our journey back to Plymouth. We aim to arrive in Bretonside around 8pm.
