IRELAND

Monday 10th – Friday 14th September

Price Incl: 4 night's Dinner, Bed & Breakfast Accommodation at the 3 star Carlton Abbey Hotel, Kildare, Ireland, plus return ferry crossings between Holyhead and Dublin and entry to the Japanese Gardens & Irish National Stud including a light lunch, Newbridge Silver Museum, Castletown House, the Village Inn including a light lunch and a day excursion to Dublin.

MONDAY -We depart Bretonside at 7am and make our way to the port of Holyhead for our ferry crossing to Dublin (time tbc), making a lunch stop along the way. On arrival in Ireland we will travel the short distance to our hotel in Kildare, where you will be served with your first evening meal.

TUESDAY – Today we enjoy a “Citycoach” exclusive guided tour of the Irish National Stud, established in 1946, home to some of Ireland’s finest thoroughbred horses. Within the grounds are the world famous St. Fiachra’s Garden and Japanese Gardens, acclaimed as the finest Japanese Gardens in Europe. We follow this with a light lunch, with sandwiches, tea, coffee and a scone. This afternoon we visit Newbridge Silver Museum, which for over 75 years has been a major name in the design of jewellery, accessories and gifts. You will also be able to view an incredible collection of paraphernalia of the stars of stage and screen; Audrey Hepburn’s iconic cocktail dress worn in “Breakfast at Tiffany’s” to Michael Jackson’s black jacket worn on his first world tour as a solo artist.

WEDNESDAY – This morning we visit Castletown House; Ireland’s largest and earliest Palladian style house, where you will have a “Citycoach” personal guided tour. This afternoon we visit the Village Inn , previously then site of James Carberry brewery, where Arthur Guinness brewed his first beer! A light lunch of soup and sandwiches followed by tea/coffee and of course a glass of Guinness is included.

THURSDAY – We spend the day in the fair city of Dublin today. You may choose to visit Trinity College, home of the “Book of Kells”, Dublin Castle and Phoenix Park. You can also wander through the cobbled streets and Georgian Squares to discover shops, art galleries, museums and cafes. You could even visit the Guinness storehouse, home to Ireland’s famous stout, and enjoy a drink in the Gravity Bar with its panoramic views of the City. (Some attractions mentioned may incur an entry fee).

FRIDAY – After breakfast we return to the ferry port for our crossing back to Holyhead (time tbc). We will make a lunch stop along the way before finishing our journey back in Plymouth arriving approximately 10pm.
