**WEDNESDAY** - We depart Bretonside at 7am and start our journey north, making a coffee stop along the way. We will make a further stop at Bridgemere Nurseries, the biggest garden centre in this area where you can have some lunch. We then have just a short journey before we arrive at our hotel and you can relax.

**THURSDAY** - Tatton Park, Cheshire's most popular visitor attraction, is our destination today. Over 750,000 visits are made each year to the 1,000 acres of deer park, Mansion, Gardens, Old Hall, rare breeds Farm and events. It has a history dating back to Bronze Age farming and has been home to herds of deer since the 13<sup>th</sup> century. Admission to the 18<sup>th</sup> century Neo-classical mansion including the state rooms and servant's quarters will be followed by a high tea of sandwiches and scones.

**FRIDAY** - We will have a short drive to the Cheshire Candle Workshop and Craft Centre today. The visit includes a 20 minute demonstration by one of the workshop craftsmen on how to make the perfect candle, including dipping the candle in wax and colouring the candle to achieve the desired look. Each guest will have the opportunity to make their own candle which can be taken home as a souvenir from the trip. We will return to our hotel for an afternoon at leisure.

**SATURDAY** - Today we have a 30 minute sightseeing tour of the City of Chester onboard a vintage open top double decker bus. Highlights include Chester Castle, Cheshire Military Museum, Chester Cathedral and Chester Visitor Centre. The remainder of your day is free to explore this delightful City steeped in history.

**SUNDAY** - Sadly we must make our way back towards the West Country today. There will be comfort stops and a longer break for lunch along the way. We aim to be back into Bretonside around 8pm.
