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PENZANCE & LANDS END

Tuesday 24th July 2012

This morning we will visit Penzance located on the shores of Mount's Bay - a body of water dominated by the grandeur of St. Michael's Mount - Penzance is Cornwall's largest and most westerly borough. Only 10 miles from Land's End, the town is surrounded by an area of Celtic culture and outstanding natural beauty. Majestic cliffs, rocky coves, pristine sandy beaches and crystal clear seas vie with the heather and gorse of the moors.

Land's End is one of Britain's best loved landmarks, famous for its unique location and beautiful scenery. A visit to this, the most south westerly point of mainland Britain, will provide you with a fantastic day out. Entrance to Land's End is free if you want to visit the four attractions within Land's End (which will incur a cost) you can purchase tickets on the day.
