*Bude has a surprisingly diverse town centre. Whilst you won't find the High Street big names, Bude still has plenty to offer. There are traditional seaside style shops selling buckets and spades and souvenirs; but it also has numerous art galleries, clothing boutiques, surf stores, and New Age mystical shops.*

*Discover the timeless village of Clovelly, where the steep, cobbled street tumbles down past gleaming white cottages to the tiny, deep-blue harbour. The street is too steep for motor vehicles, so for centuries donkeys were the main form of transport. Although they are no longer used for heavy loads, Clovelly still has its resident donkeys, and children can enjoy rides in the summer. Sensible footwear is recommended as the High Street is steep and can become slippery. For those who are unable to walk back up, there is a Land Rover service for a small fee.*
