SATURDAY

We leave Bretonside at 7.30am making a coffee stop along our way. We continue on into London where we firstly visit the Queen's Gallery. This is a permanent space at Buckingham Palace dedicated to changing exhibitions of items from the Royal Collection; the wide ranging collection of art and treasures held in trust by The Queen for the Nation. We then visit the Royal Mews and its permanent display of State vehicles both horse-drawn and motor driven. Many of which have been used for Coronations, State Visits, Royal Weddings and the State Opening of Parliament. Finally we make our way to the hotel for our evening meal.

SUNDAY

After breakfast we head back into London to visit the Household Cavalry Museum which is located within one of London's most historic buildings in Whitehall. Originally formed in 1661 under the order of King Charles II it now consists of two senior regiments, The Life Guards and the Blues and Royals. We will then make a lunch stop at Windsor with some free time to look around. We continue our journey back towards Plymouth aiming to arrive at 8pm.
