The impressive interior contains mementos and monuments to many of Britain's heroes including Nelson, Wellington and Churchill. The famous Whispering Gallery is well worth the climb. We then travel the short distance to our hotel at Heathrow where we will enjoy a 3 course evening meal.

SUNDAY – We will relax on board one of the all-weather sightseeing boats for a cruise down the River Thames this morning. Our journey takes us from Westminster to Greenwich with informative commentary along the way. We will enjoy free time in Greenwich which is set to become a Royal Borough in 2012 when Queen Elizabeth II celebrates her Diamond Jubilee. Visit the National Maritime Museum, the world's largest maritime museum, set in the beautiful surroundings of the Greenwich World Heritage Site. The Royal Observatory, home of Greenwich Mean Time and the Prime Meridian of the World, making it the official starting point for each new day and year. It is also home to London's only planetarium, the new state of the art Peter Harrison Planetarium, the centrepiece of the Royal Observatory's recent spectacular redevelopment project. We will leave Greenwich at 3.30pm and aim to arrive back into Plymouth around 9pm.
