Plymouth Citybus have invested £1.4 million into their fleet with the purchase of 11 new buses. The enviro E200's have Euro 4.5 engines - a cleaner and more fuel efficient engine which is ahead of current legislation requirement. It makes Plymouth Citybus one of the most environmentally friendly bus fleets in the country.

John Ackroyd, Managing Director, is proud of the company image and said 'As public transport providers we are conscious of our responsibility to help make Plymouth a low-pollution City. Plymouth Citybus is owned by the City Council and our profits are invested into the City's future. Councillor Vivien Pengelly, Leader of Plymouth City Council, said: "This new fleet will be a welcome boost for bus passengers in the city, offering improved comfort and better access as well as a more energy efficient, cost effective and environmentally friendly service."

The buses boast several other quality features including soft leather seats, full CCTV, colour destination blinds and next stop display on TFT screens. They have been designed to be user friendly for passengers as well as the drivers who have an improved seating area and bus maintenance engineers who have easy access areas. The investment is part of a policy to keep the fleet age at within the government's target.

Two buses will be on display in the concourse next to the Guildhall on Friday 4th and Saturday 5th July. The public are invited to step on board and offer feedback about the appearance of the bus.
