

PLYMOUTH CITYBUS WARN OF MUTLEY PLAIN ROADWORK BUS STOP AND ROUTE CHANGE

Plymouth Citybus are warning passengers to be aware of changes to bus stop locations and a route change due to the major road works at Mutley Plain. From 22nd March for approximately 6 weeks, Plymouth Citybus services will continue to use Mutley Plain but all bus stops along Mutley Plain will not be in use.

Passengers should use the temporary bus stops located on Mannamead Road just before the junction with College Avenue for buses headed towards the City Centre, and outside the Plymouth College on Hyde Park Road for buses heading towards Peverell.

For passengers wishing to travel from Mutley heading towards Mannamead, the only available stop will be outside Plymouth High School for Girls on North Hill.

Plymouth Citybus route 31 will not run via Mutley Plain or North Hill. This will be diverted to run from Mayflower Street via North Cross, North Road East, and Sutherland Road to Dale Road, then continue on normal route. On returning to the City, route 31 will run from Dale Road via Sutherland Road, North Road East and Cobourg Street to Mayflower Street.

Early morning routes 133 and 33D from Cattedown will service Tothill and divert into Hill Park Crescent and turn right onto North Hill to access Mutley Plain instead of using Greenbank Road.

Peter Oliver, Commercial Manager at Plymouth Citybus says that they hope that conditions remain favourable for so that the contractors are able to complete their works in good time: “We need to resume normal operations as soon as possible and apologise in advance for any inconvenience these works may cause to our services. We will try our hardest to maintain service during what will likely be a very difficult time for all forms of transport.”
